Contextual "All Things"

And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to [his] purpose. [Rom 8:28 KJV]

This text must be rightly divided. It must not be lifted from the context of the surrounding verses.

If you ignore these simple principles you will create a monster doctrine making God the author of sin and a house divided against Himself. This can not be.

Good and evil DO NOT work together, they are diametrically opposed to one another.

The "ALL THINGS" in Rom 8:28 are contextual.

What shall we then say to these things? If God [be] for us, who [can be] against us? [Rom 8:31 KJV]

What things?

Being foreknown, predestinated, called, justified and glorified. These are the "all things" that work for our good.
